The answer to 2016-17 Supplementary Budget Estimates question on notice 22 indicates four retail licence holders are affected by the Retail Strategy report: Aussie's Café, Capital Hairdressing, Australia Post and Sportscafe Physiotherapy and Massage.

However, given Aussie's Café was dealt with in the Food Strategy report, why is it also considered in the Retail Strategy report?

Answer

Aussies provides some retail services such as groceries, dry cleaning and newspapers and is contracted to DPS under a Licence Agreement, the same as the other retail services. Hence it was captured in both reports.
