Question:

Ms Black: I just looked at the numbers. It was about 18 per cent that had a low needs score and a low score as well, so it is about 18 per cent of the activities that were recommended for funding. We would probably have to look at each of those individually as to the rationale for the funding, which we are more than happy to do.

Answer:

Analysis of the projects recommended for funding shows that 237, or 18 per cent, of projects had a low need score, that is a score of three or less.

Of the 237 projects with a low need score, only 11 projects also had a low assessment score of 15 or less. That is, 0.9 per cent of projects recommended for funding had both a low need score and a low assessment score.

These projects were supported on the recommendation of the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet including to ensure services were not reduced in communities or to address emerging priorities.
