Senator WONG: Did you liaise with Mr Trump's team?

Mr McKinnon: I think that was done within the PM's office, but I would like to confirm that.

Senator WONG: Was that the first occasion on which you became aware that the call was proceeding?

Mr McKinnon: I would like to check that. It was a while ago and I do not recall in what sequence we heard that the call was occurring and what exactly went before it or after it.

Answer:

The Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C) did not liaise with President Trump's team in setting up the phone call between the Prime Minister, the Hon Malcolm Turnbull MP, and President Trump on 29 January 2017.

PM&C became aware the 29 January phone call would take place when a briefing request was received from the Prime Minister's Office on 28 January 2017.
