Question:

Can an itemised list of coffee machines at APSC premises please be provided including (i) make and model; (ii) purchase or lease cost; (iii) ongoing maintenance costs; (iv) ongoing cost of supplying coffee and other consumables?

Answer:

The APSC has four coffee machines in its APS Learning Centre in Woden. The APSC uses this facility to deliver a suite of leadership, learning and development programs for the APS. Details are as follows:

- (i) Three of the machines are Nespresso 220 Pro models and one is a Nespresso 200 Pro model.
- (ii) The machines were purchased in 2011. They were \$2,396 each.
- (iii) There are no known on-going maintenance costs.
- (iv) Ongoing supply costs for coffee and other consumables are less than \$1.00 per cup.
