- 6. Can the Department advise about what funding will replace the National Partnership Agreement on Remote Indigenous Housing due to end in 2018?
- 7. What funds generally will be made available for remote Indigenous communities, especially those in WA, NT and SA?
- 8. Could we have an update on the independent Remote Housing Review of the National Partnership Agreement on Remote Indigenous Housing (NPARIH) and the Remote Housing Strategy (the Strategy)?
- 9. How many meetings have taken place with Indigenous communities and businesses, housing service providers, peak bodies, land councils and state government as indicated in the Review announcement?
- 10. Where and with whom have those meetings taken place?

1 & 2. Northern Territory (NT) and Queensland (QLD) have reported the following new house completions and those underway as part of the 31 October 2016 Milestones:
