Senator McALLISTER: Could you check? You have records of your discussions, I suppose.

Answer:

The BRANDit competition was part of a suite of initiatives stemming from the *Unlocking Potential* report, released in April 2016. Many of the *Unlocking Potential* initiatives are routinely discussed with the Minister. However, these meetings are not formally recorded.

The Australian Public Service Commissioner made a decision to undertake the BRANDit competition. The Minister's approval was not sought to run it.
