Senator WONG: The terms of reference, which Mr Frydenberg released on 5 December, were released publicly. Did cabinet tick off on the terms of reference, or was there some other government process before they were announced?

Ms E Kelly: We would not normally confirm or deny matters that were discussed at cabinet because to do so would disclose the content.

Senator Brandis: That is why I sought clarification of that question. So all you are asking is whether that was a decision—

Senator WONG: They were already public. What was the genesis of those terms of reference?

Senator Brandis: I will take that on notice.
