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Question:

Senator SIEWERT: So next week is the beginning of June. I know it is being rolled out over the twelve months, but their No. 1 recommendation was that it be delayed at least six months because they are not ready.

Mr Eccles: Some will be ready, and some are ready, and some are looking forward to picking up the ball on 1 July and running with it.

Senator SIEWERT: Who are those some and where are they?

Mr Eccles: I would prefer to talk to you next week about that: we are in discussions. I know of a couple off the top of my head, but I would be reluctant to telegraph that without us having the final discussions. But I can certainly take that on notice.

Senator SIEWERT: If you could take on notice where the rollout is starting and who the providers of that are in those regions. In terms of some of the activities that are going to be provided, there was media speculation that things like "school attendance"—getting your kids to school—are going to be part of those requirements that could be classed as Work for the Dole. Is that in fact what is going to happen? What are those criteria?

Answer:

Providers in 59 of the 60 remote regions will deliver the new RJCP services from 1 July 2015. Discussions are currently underway to finalise servicing arrangements for the remaining region, Gascoyne WA.

A complete list of the RJCP providers and regions is attached.

Work-like activities are a compulsory part of a job seeker's mutual obligation requirements. Activities will be delivered flexibly and tailored to the needs of individuals and communities. These may include activities or group projects in and around schools that support school attendance. The Department is working with communities, service providers and individual state and territories to identify opportunities to support school attendance through the programme.
