**Senator WONG:** How many non-security refurbishments, construction jobs and maintenance jobs are being piggybacked onto this set of security work?

Mr Skill: Just those two lunch rooms.

Senator WONG: Two?

**Mr Skill:** The two kitchens. One at each end of the ministerial wing—the meeting rooms that go on the ground floor and first floor.

Senator WONG: How much is being spent on those?

Mr Skill: I would have to confirm that figure. I will provide it on notice.

Senator WONG: Did you tell me what the cost was, Mr Skill?

Mr Skill: No, I took that on notice. I am not sure of the most up-to-date projection for that, because the work has not been done yet.

#### Answer

The non-security related works include minor fit out works to the ground and first floor lunchrooms in the Ministerial Wing and the installation of a glass barrier to segregate the two floors to enable them to be used for meetings. The budget estimate for these works is \$575,322.
