- 2. Is Mr Mitchell retaining these offices?
- 3. If not, when is Mr Mitchell planning to leave, or has he already vacated?
- 4. If leaving / left, where has Mr Mitchell relocated?
- 5. If leaving / left, when does / did the lease on Mr Mitchell's Brighton office expire?
- 6. If the lease is still in place, what has been the cost to taxpayers of Mr Mitchell's decision to break the lease on his Brighton office?
- 7. What is the actual (or estimate) cost to the taxpayer for the establishment of Mr Mitchell's new office in Bridgewater?
- 8. In respect of Mr Mitchell's Perth office, how long is it since this was renovated?
- 9. What was the cost of that last renovation?

Answer:

- 1. Offices available to the Member for Lyons were 53B Main Road Perth and 205 Brighton Road Brighton, Tasmania.
- 2. The Perth office has been retained. The office in Brighton was not retained.
- 3. The Brighton office was vacated on 15 May 2017.
- 4. The Member for Lyons relocated to Suite 105, Green Point Plaza, 26-28 Green Point Road, Bridgewater, Tasmania.
- 5. The lease on the Brighton office expired on 31 October 2016. Following this, the lease was on a month to month arrangement, which was ceased on 31 May 2017.
- 6. N/A.
- 7. The estimated cost of the establishment of the Bridgewater office is \$90,000 (GST exclusive).
- 8. The Perth office was last renovated in April 2014.
- 9. The cost of the last renovation of the Perth office was \$218,184 (GST exclusive).
