With reference to the investigation of a major tax fraud involving certain payroll service companies, and one of the concerning aspects of this case being a number of government agencies making use of payroll companies involved:

Do any labour hire companies contracted by the Department of Parliamentary Services currently use Plutus or have any in the past 12 months used Plutus?

Has the Department of Parliamentary Services undertaken any investigation into the use of Plutus by labour hire companies?

Answer

DPS does not have information on how contracted companies manage their payroll services. DPS is not aware of any companies it has contracted being affected by the recent collapse of Plutus.
