This answer excludes staff who may be working in another location on secondment and so are not currently working for the Department of Parliamentary Services.

Answer

As at 22 June 2017, the numbers of staff were:

- a) 273 (155 Building and Security Division, 84 Information Services Division and 34 Chief Operating Officer Division).
- b) 622 (10 Secretary's Office, 156 Parliamentary Librarian, 186 Building and Security Division, 128 Information Services Division and 142 Chief Operating Officer Division).
- c) 79 in Minter Ellison Building (34 Information Services Division and 45 Chief Operating Officer Division).
