How is the AFP briefed with respect to incidents?

#### **Answer**

The initial notification of an incident to the AFP is normally initiated by an operator in the Parliamentary Security Operations Room (PSOR). Depending on the seriousness of the incident further briefings are held between the AFP Parliament House Security Controller, the AFP Station Sergeant, and the Director and Assistant Director Security Operations, Security Branch.

Following an incident the PSS provide their security incident reports to the AFP Station Sergeant through the Director Security Operations.
