The new model of SEAM in the Northern Territory was introduced to the following communities in 2013:

- <u>Commenced Term One 2013</u>: Groote Eylandt (Umbakumba, Angurugu, Alyangula), Katherine and Katherine Town Camps, Milyakburra, Ntaria (Hermannsburg), Numbulwar, Wadeye and Wallace Rockhole.
- <u>Commenced Term Three 2013</u>: Alice Springs, Yuendumu, Lajamanu, Ngukurr and Tennant Creek.
