## **Question:**

- 1. Have you retained all of the staff working in this portfolio from FaHCSIA?
  - a. If not, how many staff were lost in the merge?
  - b. What was the APS level of all staff lost in the merge, and what were their positions and areas of responsibility?
- 2. Have any additional staff been added to the indigenous affairs portfolio within the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet?

#### **Answer:**

- 1. Yes. The only exceptions are a small number of voluntary redundancies and staff who were not dedicated 100 per cent to Indigenous Affairs related work. Negotiations between the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C) and the transferring agency ensured that an appropriate proportion of such staff transferred to PM&C.
  - a. None.
  - b. Not applicable.
- 2. A small number of staff were added to the newly established Indigenous Affairs Group from existing PM&C staff to assist with the transition of Indigenous policy and programmes. No new staff were recruited from outside of PM&C or the Indigenous Affairs portfolio.
