Question: Are there any Alcohol Management Plans not within the Stronger Futures package that are being developed? If so, for which communities? Where are they up to?

Answer: Under the Breaking the Cycle of Alcohol and Drug Abuse in Indigenous Communities activity, ten communities in remote and regional Australia are being supported to develop and implement Community Alcohol and Substance Abuse Management Plans (CASPs). The locations are:

- QLD Mornington Island and Doomadgee;
- NSW Bourke, Brewarrina and Condobolin;
- SA Ceduna; and
- WA Goldfields (including Leonora and Laverton), Wiluna, East Pilbara and the Ngaanyatjarra Lands

All ten CASPs have been endorsed by the community steering committees.
