**Question:** Are there any Alcohol Management Plans not within the Stronger Futures package that are being developed? If so, for which communities? Where are they up to?

**Answer:** Under *the Breaking the Cycle of Alcohol and Drug Abuse in Indigenous Communities* activity, ten communities in remote and regional Australia are being supported to develop and implement Community Alcohol and Substance Abuse

Management Plans (CASPs). The locations are:

- QLD – Mornington Island and Doomadgee;
- NSW – Bourke, Brewarrina and Condobolin;
- SA – Ceduna; and
- WA – Goldfields (including Leonora and Laverton), Wiluna, East Pilbara and the Ngaanyatjarra Lands

All ten CASPs have been endorsed by the community steering committees.
