Questions:

1. Can the Minister explain why the Northern Land Council, as a Commonwealth Statutory Authority, is exempt from Freedom of Information laws?

- 2. Does the Minister agree that this exemption makes the NLC is less publicly accountable than other Commonwealth Statutory Authorities
- 3. Would the Minister consider removing this exemption, provided adequate protections remained for confidential traditional knowledge that was held by the Northern Land Council.

Answer:

1. Aboriginal Land Councils in the Northern Territory have been exempt from the requirement to comply with the provisions of the *Freedom of Information Act* (1982) (FOI Act) since that legislation was enacted.

The exclusion of various agencies and statutory authorities from the FOI Act was recently considered by the 'Review of the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* and *Australian Information Commissioner Act 2010*' (the Review). The Review recommended that all non-intelligence agencies be required to justify their exemption to the satisfaction of the Attorney-General within a 12 month period or lose their exemption. The report on the Review was tabled in Parliament in August 2013 and the Government is considering its response.
