Answer:

- 1. The Contestability Framework is being implemented by Finance through the Contestability Programme. The Programme is currently in the Pilot phase.
- 2. No. The Contestability Programme is reviewing a number of Government functions and if appropriate these reviews will include benchmarking.
- 3. A particular process is yet to be determined, however it is expected that the most appropriate process for benchmarking will vary depending on the function under review.
- 4. The Contestability Programme will run until June 2017.
- 5. The Contestability Programme is currently in a pilot phase and a forward program of work is yet to be determined.
