Question:

Senator MOORE: How many people are there working in the Office for Women? Could you also please provide me with an organisation chart which shows all the levels, not the names but the levels and the numbers of people working in the unit?

Ms Wallace: Senator, at the moment we have 20.1 ASL in the Office for Women, and I think we would be happy to provide you with the remainder of that question on notice.

Answer:

The Office for Women and Immigration Branch has an allocation of 23.1 full-time equivalent (FTE) staff.

- This includes 19.5 FTE dedicated to the Office for Women.
- There are 3.6 FTE in the branch supporting immigration functions. This includes 0.2 of the Assistant Secretary and 0.4 of the Senior Adviser (International Engagement and Immigration Section) positions.
