Referring to BE QoN 32, which identified Limro's desire to receive an increase in the value of the contract to cover increased labour costs of \$664,000 over three years, to reflect the *Clean Start Union Collective Agreement 2009*, effective 1 January 2010, and the decision that the Department of Parliamentary Services would not provide additional funds but would agree to \$65,479.69 per annum worth of service reductions.

- 1. Was the request to increase the value of the contract to cover increased labour costs of \$664,000 over three years brought to the attention of the presiding officers at the time or any parliamentary committee, or was the decision made at an administrative level?
- 2. Who signed off on the decision?
- 3. Did the cleaners receive the full value of the Clean Start wages?

Answer

- 1. The request for additional funds from Limro was brought to the Presiding Officers attention. The decision to negotiate changes to the statement of requirement was made by DPS.
- 2. The Deed of Variation was signed by the Acting Secretary of DPS.
- 3. Advice from Limro is that the cleaners were paid in accordance with the Clean Start agreement.
