- 2. Has this gone to tender, and if so, what is its reference number on AusTender?
- 3. If not, why has it taken over four months since Budget Estimates?
- 4. Has the cost of the consultancy been determined?
- 5. What is the timeline for the presentation of the report?
- 6. Why is this not a task that could be undertaken in-house?

#### **Answer**

- The Tender Evaluation Panel has finalised the Tender Evaluation Report and recommended the
  preferred tenderer be invited to engage in contract negotiations. These negotiations are
  underway.
- 2. Yes. AusTender reference number DPS15066.
- 3. Not applicable.
- 4. Until the tender process has been finalised, DPS are not able to provide comment on the cost of the consultancy.
- 5. The tender documentation requested a project programme be submitted based on six month delivery. Noting that the stakeholders in Parliament House have a variety of competing and priority issues, and coordination and availability for stakeholder consultation may impact the programme. Contract negotiations are underway.
- 6. The resources required to undertake this work are from a variety of professional specialist areas that DPS do not have in-house capability to deliver.
