Answer

- 1. The Chesterfield lounge was relocated to Mr Kevin Andrews (Hon) MP House of Representatives Suite RG 57.
- 2. The purchase price in 1999 was \$13,000.
- 3. The Serjeant at Arms requested that the Chesterfield lounge and two chairs be moved to Mr Andrew's suite in 2007. Mr Jason Wood subsequently requested the remaining two chairs be moved to his suite. When Mr Wood left Parliament in 2010, at Mr Andrew's request via the Serjeant at Arms, the chairs were moved to his suite, where they remain.
