2 employees: senior positions within resort	Full-time	See below
12 employees (Real Jobs Program)	32.5 hours per week (On average – daily hours are dependent on individual and community circumstances)	\$20.23 an hour
2 employees (Real Jobs Program – supervisors)	Full-time	\$57,370
1 trainee	Full-time	See below
11 regularly engaged contractors	Employed on an arms-length commercial arrangement	

\*Note employees are also provided with additional benefits dependent on their position including duty meals, subsidised accommodation and weekly food vouchers.

The salaries of the senior positions and trainee are not disclosed as the individuals could be easily identifiable due to the small numbers.
