## **Question No. 128**

### Senator Singh asked the following question at the hearing on 24 February 2014:

- 1) Has the Attorney-General met with representatives of the Minerals Council in the period between 9 September 2013 and the Senate Estimates Hearings on 24 February 2014?
- 2) If a meeting between the Attorney-General and the Minerals Council did occur, was funding of EDOs discussed at that meeting in the period between 9 September 2013 and the Senate Estimates Hearings on 24 February 2014?
- 3) Did Senator Brandis meet with representatives of the Minerals Council during 2013 prior to the Federal Election on 7 September 2013?
- 4) If a meeting between Senator Brandis and the Minerals Council did occur during 2013 prior to the Federal Election on 7 September 2013, was funding of EDOs discussed at that meeting?
- 5) Has the Attorney-General received any written representations from the Minerals Council since the Abbott Government took office on 18 September 2013 regarding funding to EDOs?
- i. If so, on what dates were those representations received?

## The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- 1) No
- 2) Not necessary to answer.
- 3) This question is not appropriate since it is directed to matters which took place prior to Senator Brandis becoming the Attorney-General. Questions at Estimates hearings are limited to the actions of the Government, not of the Opposition.

- 5) A letter from the NSW Minerals Council dated 11 October 2013 was received by the Attorney-General.
