Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 24 February 2014:

- 1) How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments since 7 September 2013?
- i. List each item of expenditure and cost
- 2) Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
- i. If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- 1) The Department spent \$22,014 on workplace ergonomic assessments under contractual arrangements between 7 September 2013 and 24 February 2014.
 - i. Items of expenditure are service costs related to external workstation assessment providers conducting on-site workstation assessments for departmental employees. Total of 51 ergonomic assessments were conducted.
- 2) Yes
 - i. Items of expenditure that have resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up from 7 September 2013 to 24 February 2014 are:
