1. I asked the AFP if Witness K's passport had been returned and was advised the status of Witness K's passport is not a matter for the AFP. Which agency has responsibility for the status of Witness K's passport?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade is responsible for passports.
