Answer:

The Department of Infrastructure and Regional Development (Infrastructure) is undertaking the *Review of Process for the Provision of Government Services at New Australian International Airports*. Submissions from industry and government stakeholders were sought, including a specific request for feedback on the current guidance material regarding border agency infrastructure requirements that is contained within the International Airport Operators Guide.

The Infrastructure review process is expected to be finalised by mid-2015.
