**Question No. AE17/105**

**Senator Bilyk asked the following question at the hearing on 28 February 2017:**

1. Can an itemised list of coffee machines at departmental premises please be provided including
  - a) make and model;
  - b) purchase or lease cost;
  - c) ongoing maintenance costs;
  - d) ongoing cost of supplying coffee and other consumables?

**The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:**

*\*Some figures are estimates as our accounting systems are not designed to capture and report these as separate items. Any greater accuracy would require an unreasonable use of departmental resources.*

Note: Coffee machines and consumables are not generally provided at departmental premises, other than as follows:

- at Australian Government Solicitor offices due to the commercial nature of AGS, and the client interface and paid client training that occurs on AGS's premises
- at Royal Commissions the department administers, due to the public interface functions of the Commissions
- at the department's Protective Security Training College, for the benefit of students attending paid training courses at the college.
