Senator Watt, Murray (L&CA 33) asked:

Senator WATT: You do not have the figure as to how many were in place at the end of the scheme?

Ms Dacey: I am sorry, I do not.

Senator WATT: Okay, you can take that on notice. Can you take on notice, unless you have it

there, that 221 figure being broken down into a year-by-year analysis as well.

Mr Manthorpe: We can take that on notice.

Answer:

On 2 March 2017, the cease date of the fast food industry labour agreement, there were 138 primary Temporary Work (Skilled) (subclass 457) visa holders working under those arrangements.

The 221 figure previously provided was not exclusive to the Fast food industry agreement as it relates to the number of visas granted across all labour agreements in the occupations of Retail Manager (ANZSCO 142111) and Retail Supervisor (ANZSCO 621511).
