Senator Watt, Murray (L&CA 33) asked:

Senator WATT: Minister Cash, were you involved in that fine-dining agreement?

Senator Cash: I was as the assistant minister for immigration at the time, yes.

minister?

Senator Cash: I would need to clarify as to whether I ultimately did finalise it. Mr Manthorpe: I cannot recall whether it was the then minister or the department.

Answer:

The parameters for the Fine Dining Labour agreement were agreed to by the then Assistant Minister for Immigration and Citizenship, Senator the Hon Michaelia Cash, on 8 April 2015, following negotiations with the hospitality sector.
