Senator Singh asked the following question at the hearing on 26-29 May 2014:

Senator SINGH: Do they get any entitlements? Is their international travel or domestic travel included?

Mr Lovelock: The chair is paid a fee. I would need to take on notice each classification of the Remuneration Tribunal that fees are paid under. Included in the package is international travel associated with managing relationships in order to deliver the fund.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The Chair is paid a fee of \$1000 per full day spent working on the Anzac Centenary Arts and Culture Fund, up to a maximum of 120 days per year. As the Chair, Sir Jonathan Mills AO FRSE, is based in the United Kingdom the contract includes provision for two return flights from the United Kingdom to Australia. Domestic travel is also covered where required.

Panel members are not paid a fee.
