Senator Carr (Written) asked:

The ABC reported on 22 Jan 2104 that Nauru 'does not have a local supply of food or water adequate for its own people'.

a. What is the capacity of the water supply system at the Regional Processing Centre? What is the maximum number of people can it supply?

b. What is the current water demand in terms of kL/day?

c. What is the current arrangement between the Australian and Nauru Governments for the provision of water to the Regional Processing Centre?

d. Is there a formal agreement guaranteeing the supply of water from Nauru Utilities Authority?

Answer:

- a. Water is currently produced via reverse osmosis water production units. This water supply is sufficient for the capacity of the centres.
- b. 365kL/day.
- c. Water is produced and stored by the Nauruan government and delivered to centres by the department's service provider.
- d. Yes.
