Senator Ludwig (Written) asked:

- 1. For the purposes of meeting its obligations under 11C of the Act, does the Department or Agency:
- 1. Maintain a webpage allowing download of documents released under section 11A (direct download)?
- 2. Require individuals to contact the Department or Agency to ask for the provision of those documents (request for provision)?
- 3. Facilitate to those documents in a different manner (if so, specify)

### Answer:

- 1. The majority of documents released in 2014 under section 11A are able to be downloaded from the individual department's disclosure log.
- 2. Individuals requesting documents prior to 2014 or those not available for downloading on the disclosure log are required to contact the FOI section of the relevant agency to obtain a hard copy of the document.
- 3. Where the number of documents is significant and publication is not practical a hard copy will be made available.
