Since the commencement of Operation Sovereign Borders, there have been 771 individuals returned of which 117 have been identified as children (under 18 years). This figure is a correction to the information provided for BE17/307. An error was found to have been made in the calculation of the previous figure. Similarly Venture number 22 in November 2015 is more appropriately characterised as an 'Assisted return'. The Department regrets these errors. The DIBP data holdings have been crosschecked and clarified. The figures provided above represent the most accurate information available to date. To preserve operational security, further details will not be disclosed.
