Answer:

Refugee status determination in Papua New Guinea (PNG) is the responsibility of the Government of PNG.

PNG is a signatory to the 1951 *Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees* and its 1967 amending *Protocol*, and as such its processes and actions regarding refugees are monitored by the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees.
