## (BE17/222) - Nauru – Positive Refugee Status Determinations - Programme 1.5: IMA Offshore Management

Senator Carr, Kim (L&CA) written:

Provide how many people have been determined to be refugees? Where have they been resettled? Where are they living now? Number that have they taken and are they living in the community?

Answer:

As at 23 May 2017, the total number of transferees determined to be refugees by the Government of Nauru was **1034**<sup>1</sup>.

Of these:

- 221 were living at the Regional Processing Centre, of these:
  One was in Papua New Guinea for medical reasons.
- **736** were living in the Nauruan community.
- 77 are no longer in Nauru.

Note<sup>1</sup>: Figure excludes 34 babies born to refugee parents.
