Senator HANSON-YOUNG: Could you take on notice how many requests you have had to provide aids, special equipment or particular modifications for people in detention who have a disability so I can get a sense of how many requests are coming through.

Individual requests for disability aids and equipment are made to both detention service providers, Serco and IHMS. The department and service providers do not collect this information in a consolidated format.
