SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES – 20 OCTOBER 2014

IMMIGRATION AND BORDER PROTECTION PORTFOLIO

(SE14/464) PROGRAMME – 2.1: and 2.2: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

Senator Hanson-Young (Written) asked:

How many applications for protection by asylum seekers have been on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity or intersex status received and determined by the Department of Immigration?

What are the outcomes of these applications for protection (successful or not)?

What is country of origin of the applicants (and separate figures for each ground)?

Answer:

Based on the manner in which claims information is recorded in departmental systems, the department is not able to provide meaningful data or analysis on the grounds for which a Protection visa application is either lodged or granted.
