Senator STERLE asked:

- 1. What is the attitude of Biosecurity Australia to the import of stone fruits?
- 2. How much stone fruit is imported each year?

Answer:

- 1. The Department of Agriculture assesses proposals to import stone fruit on the basis of biosecurity risk and in accordance with the principles of international standards and agreements. Subject to compliance with biosecurity protocols, final decisions by individual importers about where they choose to source imported product from are a commercial matter.
- 2. The Estimates Committee was advised on Tuesday 19 November 2013 that 954 tonnes of stone fruit was imported in 2012–13 and approximately 11 500 tonnes of stone fruit was exported. Between July and September 2013, Australia has imported 2665 tonnes of peaches and nectarines from the USA.
