How much does it cost to administer the office of the Coordinator-General for remote services annually? How many staff are employed in the office of the Coordinator-General for remote services?

Answer:

As an independent statutory officer the Coordinator General is currently supported by 13 Australian Public Service staff employed by the Department of Families, Housing, Community services and Indigenous Affairs. The budget for the Office of the Coordinator General for Remote Indigenous Services is funded from departmental appropriations.
