## Senator Fifield asked:

Was one of the criteria for the successful applicants for the Leaders for Tomorrow program to have an established leadership program already in place?

## Answer:

The selection criteria were:

- 1. Demonstrated capacity to deliver an individualised support service for people with disability to facilitate leadership skills development.
- 2. Demonstrated capacity to conduct regular application processes to select participants.
- 3. Ability of the organisation (or consortium) to allocate financial support to participants to cover the costs of undertaking the leadership development.
- 4. Demonstrated capacity to deliver a service which meets the needs of participants, including Indigenous Australians, people who live in regional and remote areas, women, young Australians and people from non-English speaking backgrounds.
- 5. Demonstrated expertise and qualifications of staff to achieve quality outcomes in delivering the services sought.
