Senator Fifield asked:

Was one of the criteria for the successful applicants for the Leaders for Tomorrow program to have an established leadership program already in place?

Answer:

The selection criteria were:

1. Demonstrated capacity to deliver an individualised support service for people with disability to facilitate leadership skills development.
2. Demonstrated capacity to conduct regular application processes to select participants.
3. Ability of the organisation (or consortium) to allocate financial support to participants to cover the costs of undertaking the leadership development.
4. Demonstrated capacity to deliver a service which meets the needs of participants, including Indigenous Australians, people who live in regional and remote areas, women, young Australians and people from non-English speaking backgrounds.
5. Demonstrated expertise and qualifications of staff to achieve quality outcomes in delivering the services sought.
