## **Senator** Fifield asked:

Can the Department provide a list of all the final project reports that it has received and those that it has not?

## **Answer:**

The Capital Works Funding Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) requires jurisdictions to have completed the total number of supported accommodation places by June 2012. It is expected that the majority of final project reports will be received during 2011-12.

Under the MOU, jurisdictions are required to provide the Department with final project reports for each facility within 30 business days of practical completion, and a final acquittal report within 90 business days of practical completion of the last facility completed under the project.

To date, the Department has received 48 final project reports and one final acquittal report, 12 months prior to the end of MOU.
