CLARIFICATION OF INFORMATION TO SENATE COMMUNITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE – 1 JUNE 2011

I am writing to clarify an answer that I provided during the Community Affairs Committee's examination of Output 4.1, Income Support for Seniors of the Department of Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs (FaHCSIA) on 1 June 2011.

In response to a question from Senator Mark Furner about the benefit to pensioners of the new Work Bonus, I stated that, 'The direct impact of that would be that the person's pension would go up by \$20 a fortnight'.

My answer should have been, '...would go up by \$25 a fortnight'.

I note that as a result of my error, Senator Furner subsequently stated that in relation to a combined pension household "...the savings would be \$40 between the two, is that correct?

Had I stated the correct figure, Senator Furner would have stated '\$50' (correct figure) instead of '\$40'.

I apologise for this error and I am seeking your agreement to amend the transcript of the Committee's proceedings to reflect the correct answer.
