Answer:

This model was recommended by Grandparents Australia.

The peer support group National Coordinator will be required to build and maintain good relationships and collaborations with all relevant stakeholders including Commonwealth, state and territory governments, local service providers and local grandparent organisations operating in MyTime for Grandparents peer support group locations, to ensure integrated services are provided to grandparent carers.

The timing and topics of the peer support group sessions are expected to be flexible and driven by participants' needs to maximise their participation and benefits from discussions.
