#### Answer:

#### Department of the Environment (the Department)

With the exception of the detail below there have been no changes to this information ie no changes since November 2013:

d) Yes. An EL2 officer inadvertently used their card for personal expenditure (\$1,001.81). This was realised immediately and a refund was requested at point of purchase. Unfortunately only a partial refund could be made by the vendor. Arrangements are in place for the remaining amount to be repaid to the Department.
