- b. 28. SBS Band 1 – 1; SBS Band 2 – 3; SBS Band 3 – 8; SBS Band 4 – 2; SBS Band 5 – 4; SBS Band 6 – 1; SBS Band 7 – 1; Executive (including Common Law Contract) – 8.
