**Topic: Staffing Recruitment**

**Senator Ludwig asked:**

- a. How many ongoing staff recruited from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- b. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- c. From 7 September 2013 to date, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

**Answer:**

- a. 11. SBS Band 1 – 3; SBS Band 3 – 3; SBS Band 6 – 5. Includes 8 full time and 3 part time.
- b. 78. SBS Band 1 – 4; SBS Band 2 – 8; SBS Band 3 – 38; SBS Band 4 – 14; SBS Band 5 – 2; SBS Band 6 – 3; SBS Band 7 – 3; Executive Contract – 5; Contributor – 1. For SBS Bands 1-7, this includes 52 casual, 17 specified period, and 3 specified task.
- c. 15. Two years.

Note: All answers include NITV staff and SBS Subscription TV staff. SBS is not an Australian Public Service agency and employees are not employed under the Public Service Act 1999. SBS does not classify staff as SES/non-SES.
