Senator Ludwig asked:

- 1. Has the department/agency purchased coffee machines for staff usage since 7 September 2013?
 - a. If yes, provide a list that includes the type of coffee machine, the cost, the amount, and any ongoing costs such as purchase of coffee or coffee pods and when the machine was purchased?
 - b. Why were coffee machines purchased?
 - c. Has there been a noticeable difference in staff productivity since coffee machines were purchased? Are staff leaving the office premises less during business hours as a result?
 - d. Where did the funding for the coffee machines come from?
 - e. Who has access?
 - f. Who is responsible for the maintenance of the coffee machines? How much was spent on maintenance from 7 September 2013 to date, include a list of what maintenance has been undertaken. Where does the funding for maintenance come from?
 - g. What are the ongoing costs of the coffee machine, such as the cost of coffee?
- 2. Does the department/agency rent coffee machines for staff usage?
 - a. If yes, provide a list that includes the type of coffee machine, the cost, the amount, and any ongoing costs such as purchase of coffee or coffee pods and when the machine was purchased.
 - b. Why are coffee machines rented?
 - c. Has there been a noticeable difference in staff productivity since coffee machines were rented? Are staff leaving the office premises less during business hours as a result?
 - d. Where does the funding for the coffee machines come from?
 - e. Who has access?
 - f. Who is responsible for the maintenance of the coffee machines? How much was spent on maintenance from 7 September 2013 to date, include a list of what maintenance has been undertaken. Where does the funding for maintenance come from?
 - g. What are the ongoing costs of the coffee machine, such as the cost of coffee?

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Answer:

- 1. No. (a) to (g) not applicable.
- 2. Yes.
 - a. One Nespresso Tower CS220 Coffee Machine for the Audio Language Content Division (ALC). It is rented at a cost of \$882 per quarter (pre GST). There are no ongoing costs for coffee or coffee pods. These are paid for by staff at their own expense.
 - b. Due to the nature of the ALC Division business, a significant number of staff work outside normal business hours, with 80% of staff in ALC being production staff (either producing or broadcasting live radio programs). Facilitating staff access to coffee has improved both morale and productivity within the Division.
 - c. Yes, staff are able to quickly access the Nespresso Unit, without having to leave the production floor.
 - d. The ALC Division has provided for the lease of the equipment in its annual budget.
 - e. All staff across the Division have access, as well as anybody else in the organisation who wishes to save time and avoid leaving the premises to purchase their coffee.
 - f. SBS is responsible for maintenance. There has been no maintenance cost to date. If required, this would be paid for within the ALC Division's annual budget.
 - g. There are no ongoing costs such as purchase of coffee or coffee pods. These are paid for by staff at their own expense.
